

Returns from the Pitt Rivers Museum

Updated October 2025

- Six ancestral remains returned to Australia in 1990.
- One ancestral remain returned to the Haida Nation, Canada in 2010.
- Eleven ancestral remains and associated cultural material returned to the Fort McDowell Yavapai Nation of Arizona, USA, in 2014.
- Ten ancestral remains of Māori and Moriori people returned to Aotearoa New Zealand in 2017.
- Seventeen ancestral remains and one associated object returned to Australia in 2022 and 2023.
- One sunhat returned to the Kenyah Badeng Association of Sarawak in November 2024.
- Five ancestral remains returned to the Tasmanian Aboriginal Centre in March 2025.
