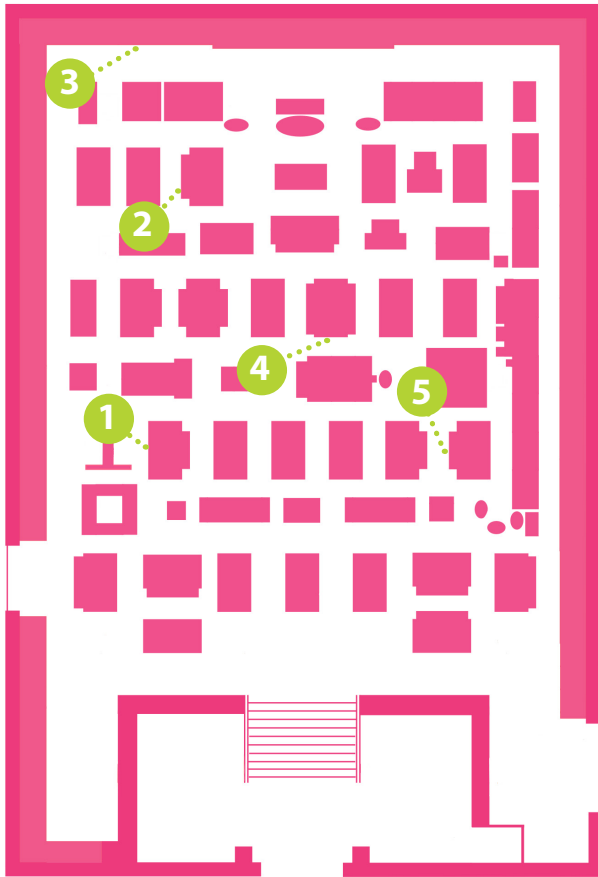

The handle on this baler is carved into a face with a tongue sticking out. Spot the different carved designs on each of the canoe balers!



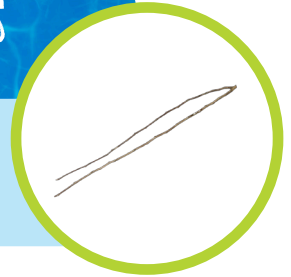
4. BIRD WHISTLE England

Used to help you find water hidden underground!



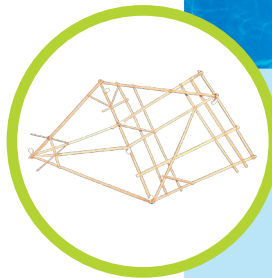
1. OSTRICH EGG South Africa
